1/9/23 - Voted AGAINST <u>H.R. 23: To rescind certain balances made available to the Internal Revenue Service.</u>

Himes twice voted to fund \$80 billion for 37,000 IRS agents to audit middle-class taxpayers

1/27/23 - Voted AGAINST H.R. 21: Strategic Production Response Act

• Bill called for increasing U.S. oil & gas production

2-2-23 - Voted AGAINST H.Con.Res. 9: Denouncing the horrors of socialism.

• Himes was one of about only 50 who REFUSED to denounce the Socialist System

2/1/23 - Voted AGAINST H.R. 139: SHOW UP Act of 2023

• Bill required having Fed Employees 'Show Up' in person for work

3/24/23 - Voted AGAINST H.R. 5: Parents Bill of Rights Act

• Bill left all school control at the local level. But it required local transparency in all aspects of school curricula and administration, and any sexuality-focused student-teacher discussions.

3/20/23 - Voted AGAINST H.R. 1: Lower Energy Costs Act

Bill called for increasing American energy production, exports, and infrastructure

4/20/23 - Voted AGAINST H.R. 734: Protection of Women and Girls in Sports Act of 2023

• Bill required that **only biological women** compete in women's K-12 and college sports

5/11/23 - Voted AGAINST H.R. 2: Secure the Border Act of 2023

• Bill called for extensive physical, technical and human resources be rushed to secure the border

6/14/23 - Voted AGAINST H.R. 1640: Save Our Gas Stoves Act

• Bill would prohibit Secretary of Energy from regulating gas stoves out from consumer use

6/22/23 - Voted AGAINST <u>H.Res. 461: Condemning the use of elementary and secondary school facilities to provide shelter for aliens who are not admitted to the United States.</u>

 Himes refused to even condemn the use of K-12 schools for purpose of sheltering illegals and displacing the children.

11/2/23 - Voted AGAINST H.R. 6126: Israel Security Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2024

Himes voted Bill down, insisting Aid to Israel be coupled with Ukraine aid

11/30/23 - Voted AGAINST H.R. 5961: No Funds for Iranian Terrorism Act

• Bill called for freezing the remaining Iranian funds/assets left in the U.S.

12-13-23 – Voted AGAINST <u>H.Res. 927: Condemning antisemitism on University campuses and the testimony of University Presidents in the House Committee on Education and the Workforce.</u>

Himes wouldn't even condemn antisemitism on university campuses

11/1/23 - Voted AGAINST H.Res. 559: Declaring it is the policy of the United States that a nuclear Islamic Republic of Iran is not acceptable.

• Himes was only one of 53 voting against the Resolution to prevent Iran from obtaining a Nuclear Weapon
